- · We ask that you assist by keeping your stairwells, porches, walkways, and entry areas clear of snow and salted for safety.
- · Joe Boylan has cleared most of our parking areas and will be doing additional cleanup throughout the day.
- · Your boilers and furnaces exhaust through a vent in the side of your house/building. In a few instances you may not find a sign as your mechanical may vent out your chimney. When the exhaust does not vent properly it can create a life threatening carbon monoxide release in your apartment/house.

The vents are all marked with a red and white sign that reads:

Please keep vent clear of snow and debris.

Please help by ensuring that your vent is kept clear during heavy snowfall and on blustery days when the snow is moving around.
