

# The 7 SPRING Move Out TIPS

**1 Don't let your roommates leave you hanging.** Have a conversation with your roommates. Plan ahead and talk about how to share responsibilities. Don't expect the last person moving out to take care of everything!

**2 Keep the greenbelt clean: It's the law!**

**3 Eligible for FREE furniture pick-up?**  
Early Bird Bonus: You can get a FREE pick up by calling ReSTORE a couple weeks before your move out date: (802) 658-4143 ex.19.

**4 Don't shop: SMOP! It's free to recycle!**  
Bring furniture, clothing, and household items in good condition (no rips & stains) to the Spring Move Out Project (SMOP) swap on Wed., May 23rd, 11am-3pm, 2 locations: Loomis St. and Bradley St.

**5 If it's really junk, throw it away for a small on-site fee.** Bring furniture in poor condition to the SMOP dumpsters (rate sheet on the back). Other options: Head to CSWD Drop Off Center, 339 Pine St. (details on back) or call 1-800-GOT-JUNK 24/7. Use your FREE CarShare Vermont membership sponsored by UVM to haul stuff: see [www.carsharevt.org](http://www.carsharevt.org).

**6 Don't lose your security deposit.**  
Clean your apartment thoroughly - the oven, refrigerator, bathroom, windows, floors, etc.

**7 Put trash and recycling in the right places.** Avoid fines by properly disposing of trash. Out of room for your trash? Contact your landlord. Get recycling bins at the Department of Public Works at 645 Pine St. When you move, leave recycle bins for the next tenants.

Fees based on size of item. Examples:

mattress .....\$7-14

couch .....\$14

recliner .....\$7

couch with bed/recliner \$17

(No TVs!)



Call 1-800-GOT-JUNK for delivery of items from your home to a dumpster for an additional \$10/item.

**ELECTRONICS:** It is illegal to throw electronics in the trash (computers, monitors & peripherals, e-devices (PDAs, MP3 players, etc), TVs & digital converter boxes, phones, game consoles, stereos, VCRs, DVD players, etc. TV's and computers are accepted for free at ReSTORE and CSWD Drop-Off Centers (fees apply for some items).
