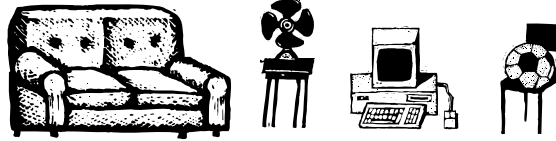

CURBSIDE RECYCLING



The City of Burlington provides weekly curbside pick-up of household recyclables including bottles, cans, mixed paper, and cardboard.

TRASH - costs cash



The City of Burlington does NOT pick up trash from households.

Examine your lease and contact your landlord to determine how extra trash is to be handled at moving time. You and/or your landlord **must** make provisions for trash removal, or you will be fined.

If you want to have trash picked up from your residence by a private hauler,

- see "Garbage" in the Yellow Pages.

If you want to deliver trash directly to a disposal site (haul it yourself), go to:

- CSWD's Burlington or South Burlington DOC trash fees are based on volume
33-gallon bag = \$2.75; couch = \$12; recliner = \$6 (see hours and locations under CLOTHING)

- All Cycle Waste Transfer Station **large quantities** (minimum fee is \$37)
